Conditions of Entry and General Information

- 1. Conditions of Sale:** Held under the Livestock Auctioneers Association conditions of sale.
- Entry is open to MV and Non MV Accredited Sheep. All MV Accredited sheep must hand in an in date MV certificate on arrival to the Mart. Entries will only be accepted from fully paid-up Members of the Association.
- Shearling ewes and Flock ewes must be fully registered. Ewe lambs to be notified. Rams can be either notified or fully registered.
- Show & Sale classes: Class 1 - Shearling Ewe Class 2 - Ewe Lamb Class 3 - Flock Ewe Class 4 - Shearling Ram Class 5 - Ram Lamb Class 6 – 2 or 3-shear Ram
- All sheep must be docked in accordance with UK legislation and earmarked in accordance with ODSBA and UK government regulations.
- Each vendor must submit a completed and signed Vendor Declaration to the Flock Book Editor by the entry closing date. Failure to do so will result in the entries being rejected.

Council reserves the right to inspect any sheep that in their opinion breaches the declaration. Such inspection shall be conducted by two Association members appointed by Council. The outcome of the inspection shall be final and binding. There will be no right to appeal. Any sheep failing such in-spection shall be removed from both the show and the sale.

- All sheep other than lambs must have been bare shorn after 1st March in the current season
- Sheep shall be presented in their natural colour. The application of any colouring material to the fleece is not permitted.
- All sheep will be sold in guineas (105 pence) and a commission of 5.5% will be charged by the Auctioneers on all sales.
- Details of any substitute to be notified to the Association in advance of sale day, displayed on the pen, announced in the ring, and identified by a red paint dot on the back.
- It is the responsibility of vendors and purchasers to ensure that all DEFRA regulations regarding the movement of sheep are adhered to.
- Any sheep sold after the sale out of the ring must be put through the auctioneers' books.
- An Association Levy of 2% will be deducted from the vendors account and paid to the Oxford Down Sheep Breeders Association.
- An upset price will be set of 150gns for Rams.
- Entry Fee – a fee of £10+VAT per head will be charged on all entries. Cheques to be made payable to Harrison & Hetherington Ltd and must accompany the completed entry form. Entry fees are non-refundable. If you prefer to pay by Bacs, please call the office for details.

Acceptance of stock: The arrival of stock can only be accepted onto the market premises within the time period stated in the sale catalogue. Any alteration will be notified to all vendors, however we request that all arrival times must be strictly adhered to when published in the catalogue.
