Conditions of Entry and General Information

- 1. Entry is open to MV Accredited Sheep only.
- 2. All sheep must be registered with the Beltex Sheep Society and all fees paid, prior to the closing date of entries, with the exception of the Recipient dams. Any lambs sold at foot must be Birth notified and if sold with their dam must be fully registered by the Vendor prior to transfer.

NO UNREGISTERED ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

- 1. Classes available for Pedigree Ewes & Lambs, ET Pedigree Lambs Suckling Recipient Dam, Ewe Hoggs. No weaned ET lambs will be accepted
- 2. All sheep must be double tagged. The vendor shall be responsible for the correctness of identity. Any tags which are tampered with, hand written/bear marks, are faulty or illegible will be rejected from the sale.
- 3. Entry Fee a fee of £15.60 per unit will be charged on all entries (£13 + VAT). Cheques to be made payable to Harrison & Hetherington Ltd and must accompany the completed entry form unless paying by BACS. Sort Code: 82-70-24 Account Number: 00300044 Please use your Account number as reference.
- 4. Scrapie Genotyping is voluntary. Genotype information to be displayed in the sale catalogue must be supported by valid genotype certificates forwarded along with the sale entry forms and pedigree certificates.
- 5. ALL substitutes to be notified to the Beltex sheep Society. All substitutes must be notified by 12noon on Wednesday 22nd May and must be marked with a red dot on the loin. The will be a cap on the number of substitute entries which will be limited to two per section.

No substitutes will be allowed at the point for Arrival of Stock.

- 6. Transfers Any sheep to be sold at Society sales must be registered (with the exception of lambs at foot, see point 2 above) in the flock from which it is to be sold by 31st May in the year of sale.
- 7. Embryos females which have been flushed and embryos recovered before sale must be declared in the catalogue and announced at the time of sale. Failure to do so will result in the purchaser having the right to return the sheep. Costs may be incurred.
- 8. All sheep entered for Society sales must be inspected by a panel of Veterinary Officers and Inspectors appointed by the Society.
- 9. The inclusion of any animal in the sale following any inspection is no warranty that the animal meets any criteria or criterion in respects of any standard or will do so in future.
- 10. Sale Ring Rule any sheep which has not pass Society inspection must not be offered for sale, or advertised or promoted, in the ring.
- 11. No animal to be sold outside of the ring before being offered for sale in the sale ring.
- 12. All animals MUST be sold in sale catalogue order.

PRE-SALE INSPECTION: All sheep forward for the sale will be subject to a Society inspection. Any animal which does not reach the Inspection standard will not be eligible for show or sale. The inspection decision will be final and any animal failed must be removed immediately from the sale and forfeit the entry fee. No appeal is permitted.

- 1. Tags which do not comply with UK legislation and Society requirements will result in the sheep being rejected at inspection. All registered sheep must carry tags with the Society logo. Check that tags are correct at time of entry, so that replacement tags can be ordered before the sale.
- 2. Sheep which have failed inspection must be removed immediately from the market premises. Vendors are advised to check their animals thoroughly prior to departure from home.
- 3. Any animal rejected for incorrect mouth is not allowed to be entered or substituted at following Society sales.
- 4. Inspection will include the following points: Tags, Teeth, Mobility Udder, Muscularity and any other points deemed necessary by Council as they see fit.
- 5. Inspection Standards
 - Teeth to be inspected and assessed at the discretion of the inspector/veterinary officer. No tampering is allowed.
 - Sheep should be mobile and sound.
 - Double muscling, the animal should display double-muscled gigots.
 - Udder should be correct and free of abnormalities.
 - Fleece should be tight. A medium fleece may be acceptable.

Acceptance of stock: Due to Defra regulations, the arrival of stock can only be accepted onto the market premises within the time period stated in the sale catalogue. Any alteration will be notified to all vendors, however, we request that all arrival times must be strictly adhered to.
