KERRY HILL FLOCK BOOK SOCIETY SALES CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) Only members of the KHFBFS may enter sheep.
- 2) All sheep must be registered and have Society ear tag. Entries will not be accepted unless the ear tag corresponds with that recorded in the relevant flock book. Lambs must have official ear tags.
- 3) The Vendor must ensure that ALL sheep have been previously registered prior to entry to the Sale. In addition, all sheep must be identified in accordance with current Defra regulations (or equivalent authority).
- 4) Sheep must conform to KHFBFS standards. Please refer to the breed standard set out in the flock book. (Copies of the breed standard are available from the Administrator if required)
- 5) Sheep must be correct in mouth, udder & testicles & free from all signs of lameness & any contagious or infectious diseases.
- 6) All sheep entered for the sale will be inspected by an independent inspector appointed by the Society. Any sheep not tagged to KH Society & DEFRA (or equivalent authority) specification or not meeting the breed or health standards will be rejected. Vendors will be asked to remove the said animal(s) immediately from the sale yard. The Auctioneers will not be permitted to sell such sheep.
- 7) Yearling ewes must not show more than two broad teeth. Ewes aged 2 years and over showing forward teeth must be declared at the time of sale otherwise they are returnable.
- 8) If a ewe has run with a ram prior to the sale this must be stated when she enters the ring. Otherwise, vendors will be held responsible if in default.
- 9) All vendors must have any licences or other documentation required by Defra (Or equivalent authority). Failure to present this will result in exclusion from the sale. Vendors must also be aware of, and follow, all current Defra instructions regarding livestock sales.
- 10) No entry fees will be refunded.
- 11) No late or verbal entries will be accepted.
- 12) Vendors are responsible for the accuracy of all information given regarding their sheep.
- 13) No substitutes will be allowed unless a veterinary certificate is presented to the Secretary who must be notified as soon as possible before the sale.
- 14) All sheep must be penned in catalogue order and sold as catalogued, i.e.- single entries as singles: a pair as a pair. Society
- 15) All sheep must be clearly identified with the relevant lot number.
- 16) Whilst every care will be taken in the preparation of the catalogue, neither the KHFBFS nor the Auctioneers can be held responsible for errors.
- 17) Members are responsible for obtaining their own official ear tags.
- 18) Vendors will not be allowed to enter more than 10 sheep in a run. Up to two further runs of 10 will be balloted in the same way. If the vendor wishes Ewes/Ewe Lambs can be entered and sold as pairs or multiple
