NEMSA Sale Rules

1. Lambs presented at Association Sales must be the bona-fide property of members and tagged with a tag bearing the NEMSA logo and UK flock number
2. They must be sired by a pure Bluefaced Leicester ram, out of either a Swaledale or Northumberland type Blackface ewe.
3. At Association Sales, all lambs forward will be subject to the scrutiny of inspectors.
4. Any member whose stock is deemed to be of incorrect parentage will be warned in writing the first year, then, if there is no improvement the following year, their membership will be terminated.
5. There shall be no black lambs.
6. The use of coloured yarns to mark pens of lambs is banned.
7. Any disputes arising as a result of these rules will be settled by the Council of Management of the Association.
8. Consignments found incorrectly tagged will be moved to the end of the sale.

Payment due on Day of Purchase

Interest chargeable from date of purchase at 7.25% over Clydesdale Bank base rate at the time, for accounts in default. Purchases shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law in England and Scotland

2% surcharge will apply to Business Credit Card payments

If payment is made by credit card, it must be linked to a business bank account
