Conditions of Entry and General Information

1. The sale is governed by the rules and constitution of the British Rouge Sheep Society. These are available on the Society website and in the back of the yearbook.
2. All Sheep will be sold under the Livestock Auctioneers Association conditions of sale
3. All sheep entered must be MV Accredited.
4. All sheep must be registered with the British Rouge Sheep Society.
5. Sale order will be Gimmers, Ewe Lambs, Aged Ewes followed by Shearling Rams, Lamb Rams and Aged Rams. Classes also available for Rou-teX rams and females. This is for a Rouge ewe crossed with a Beltex, Texel or Dutch Texel ram.
6. All sheep must have official ear tattoos or tags and also be tagged in accordance with the relevant DEFRA regulations. The Vendor shall be responsible for the correctness of identity.
7. Any animal which has been genotyped can have the result printed in the sale catalogue, but only if a valid certificate or copy of summary sheet of the genotype is presented with the sale entry form.
8. All Pedigree Certificates must accompany the completed entry form.
9. Entry Fees – A fee of £10 + VAT (£12) per head will be charged on all entries. Cheques to be made payable to Harrison & Hetherington Limited and must accompany the completed entry form. BACS payment will be accepted, please call the office to receive your unique reference code. Acc 00300044 Sort: 82-70-24

Entries only be accepted if full payment is made.

10. There will be an 'Upset Price' as follows – Shearling and Older Rams and Females 300gns, Lamb Rams 250gns and Ewe Lambs 200gns.
11. All 2 Shear Ewes and older to have produced a lamb which has been birth notified with the Society. Aged Rams must have progeny registered with the society.

Year letter – D = Shearlings and E = Lambs

12. All sheep forward for the sale will be subject to an Inspection by the Society Inspector. If a sheep fails inspection the owner has the option to pay £20 for an appeal. This will be to the Chairperson, the appeal panel (as per Society) decision will be final and any animal failed will be removed from the sale and forfeit any entry fee.

13. Substitute entries will be accepted, but the information must be with the Auctioneers one week prior to the sale day. Substitutes are restricted to one entry per five entries. Substitute entries must be marked with a red dot on the shoulder.

Acceptance of stock: The arrival of stock can only be accepted onto the market premises within the time period stated in the sale catalogue. Any alteration will be notified to all vendors, however we request that all arrival times must be strictly adhered to when published in the catalogue.

Export to Northern Ireland: As of 1 January 2021, the rules for exporting sheep from the United Kingdom to Northern Ireland and the European Union have changed for moving breeding stock to Northern Ireland – **NO Direct Export or Vendor Returns will be available.**

It will be the responsibility of the purchaser and/or the vendor to make any necessary arrangements for sheep going to Northern Ireland.

Disclaimer: The responsibility for export of sheep rests with either the purchaser or the vendor and not Harrison & Hetherington Ltd nor the British Rouge Sheep Society.
