Conditions of Entry and General Information

1. All Sheep will be sold under the Livestock Auctioneers Association conditions of sale
2. Entry is open to MV and Non MV Accredited Sheep.
3. All sheep must be double tagged. The vendor shall be responsible for the correctness of identity. Any tags which are tampered with, hand written/bear marks, are faulty or illegible will be rejected from the sale.
4. All sheep entered for sale MUST be fully registered. All pedigree certificates will be sent direct from the society to the purchasers after the sale, pedigree certificates are not necessarily required to be sent with the entry form.
5. Substitutes - details of any substitute MUST be notified to the society secretary no less than 48 hours prior to the sale and details to be displayed on the pen so potential purchasers are aware of any lot which has been substituted.
6. Scrapie Genotyping is voluntary. Genotype information to be displayed in the sale catalogue must be supported by valid genotype certificates forwarded along with the sale entry forms and pedigree certificates.
7. Entry Fee – a fee of £12 per head will be charged on all entries (£10 + VAT). Cheques to be made payable to Harrison & Hetherington Ltd and must accompany the completed entry form. Entry fees are non-refundable.
8. An upset price will be set of 300gns for shearling and older rams and females. Ram lambs 250gns and ewe lambs will be 200gns.
9. All sheep forward will be subject to a Society Inspection. Any animal which does not reach the inspection standard will not be eligible for sale. The Society decision will be final, and any animal failed will be removed from the sale and forfeit the entry fee.
10. The following minimum weights will apply – RAMS 50kgs lambs, 75kgs shearlings; FEMALES 40kgs lambs

Acceptance of stock: The arrival of stock can only be accepted onto the market premises within the time period stated in the sale catalogue. Any alteration will be notified to all vendors, however we request that all arrival times must be strictly adhered to when published in the catalogue.

Export to Northern Ireland: As of 1 January 2021, the rules for exporting sheep from the United Kingdom to Northern Ireland and the European Union have changed for moving breeding stock to Northern Ireland – **NO Direct Export or Vendor Returns will be available.**

It will be the responsibility of the purchaser and/or the vendor to make any necessary arrangements for sheep going to Northern Ireland.

Disclaimer: The responsibility for export of sheep rests with either the purchaser or the vendor and not Harrison & Hetherington Ltd nor the Roussin Sheep Society.
