Conditions of Entry and General Information

1. The Show and Sale will be held subject to the General & Special Conditions of Sale of the Institute of Auctioneers and Appraisers in Scotland.
2. **Only rams from registered sires will be eligible for entry into the sale.** Rams without registered sires will be refused. Please ensure that the sires name and flock book number are shown on the entry form.
Vendors must ensure that all ram details are available to be included in the catalogue.
3. **All rams must be guaranteed correct of their mouths on the day of the sale.** All vendors and purchasers must be aware that once again trust should prevail regarding correct mouths. On delivery of rams and whereby a fault is found this should be reported to the company within 24 hours together with a deposit of £20. The deposit of £20 will be returnable if the complaint is sustained, otherwise it will be forfeited. A referee will be appointed to act in any disputes and the findings will be binding to both parties.
4. Please complete all Insurance details on the entry form.
5. **All rams must have had a clear test for Ovine Achondroplasia. Vendors will be required to show proof of a clear test if requested by the Cheviot Sheep Society.**
6. £300 will be the minimum price for a ram sold in the ring or outwith.
7. One substitute per vendor will be permitted.
8. All vendors must be fully paid-up members of the Cheviot Hill Sheep Society.
9. Society entry fee of £10 + VAT per head should accompany all entry forms. All cheques to be made payable to Harrison & Hetherington Ltd. If you wish to pay by Bacs please call the Pedigree Office for details.
10. Ballot will take place on Tuesday 16th September.
11. All sheep must be identified with numbers stamped on their back.

Acceptance of stock – due to Defra regulations, the arrival of stock can only be accepted onto the market premises within the time period stated in the sale catalogue. Any alteration will be notified to all vendors, however, we request that all arrival times must be strictly adhered to when published in the catalogue.

All rams sold must be registered in the subsequent Flock Book unless previously registered.
