Conditions of Entry and General Information

1. The Sale will be held subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Blue Texel Sheep Society, the Conditions of Sale as recommended by the LAA and the Auctioneers Standard Conditions of Sale.
2. Entry is open to **MV Accredited Sheep only**. All consignors must be a full Member of the Society provided their subscriptions are up to date.
3. Classes available for all ages of Pedigree Rams and Females:
Class 1 - Aged Ewe; Class 2 - Shearling Gimmer; Class 3 - Ewe Lamb
Class 4 - Aged Ram; Class 5 - Shearling Ram; Class 6 - Ram Lamb
4. Entry Allowance: (per Vendors Flock Code)
Maximum of 2 Aged Rams, 6 Shearling Rams and 5 Ram Lambs
Maximum of 10 females per class (female entries capped at an overall total of 18 lots)
5. All sheep must be double tagged. The secondary tag will show the UK number and individual ID and should also contain Society registered management information. The vendor shall be responsible for the correctness of identity. Any tags which are tampered with, hand written/bear marks, are faulty or illegible will be rejected from the sale.
6. **PRE-SALE INSPECTION:** All sheep forward for the sale will be subject to a Society inspection. Any animal which does not reach the Inspection standard will not be eligible for sale. **The inspection decision will be final and any animal failed must be removed immediately from the market and forfeit the entry fee. No appeal is permitted.** Rejected sheep will be marked with a green dot.
7. All sheep will be sold in guineas (105 pence) and a commission of 5.5% will be charged by the Auctioneers on all sales.
8. A Society Levy of 1% will be deducted from the vendors account and paid to the Blue Texel Sheep Society.
9. All sheep entered for the sale must be fully pedigree registered prior to the closing date of entries. All pedigree certificates must be forwarded with the entry form.
10. An upset price will be set of 300gns on each sheep presented for sale.
11. Entry Fee – a fee of 10+VAT (£12) per head will be charged on all entries. Please contact the Pedigree Office to receive your individual reference code. Acc: 00300044 Sort: 82-70-24 Entry fees are non-refundable.
12. All Rams and Females are sold with a Vendors Warranty, full details of the warranty's are available from the Blue Texel Sheep Society.
13. Scrapie Genotyping is voluntary. Genotype information to be displayed in the sale catalogue must be supported by valid genotype certificates forwarded along with the sale entry forms and pedigree certificates.
14. Transfer Fee – a fee of £5 will be charged to the purchaser if they wish to transfer their purchase into their flock.

ALL SHEEP MUST BE BACK STAMPED

Acceptance of stock: The arrival of stock can only be accepted onto the market premises within the time period stated in the sale catalogue. Any alteration will be notified to all vendors,

however we request that all arrival times must be strictly adhered to when published in the catalogue.
